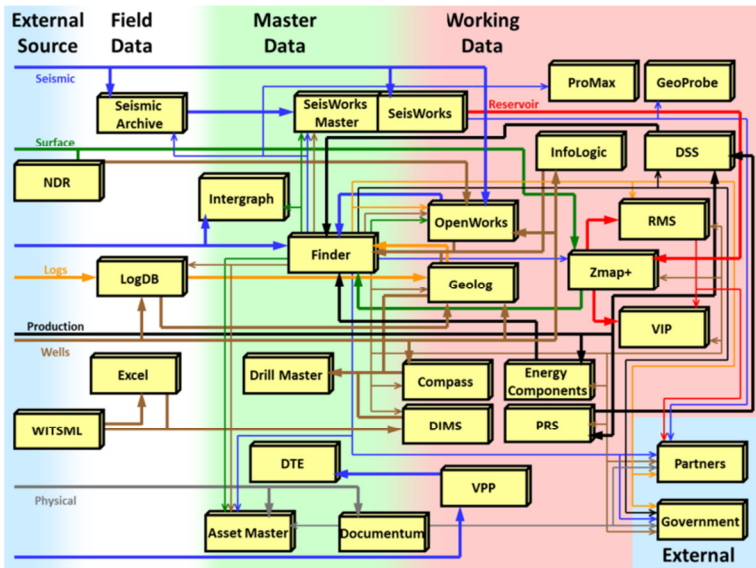


Figure 75: The wrong way to document data flows in E&P

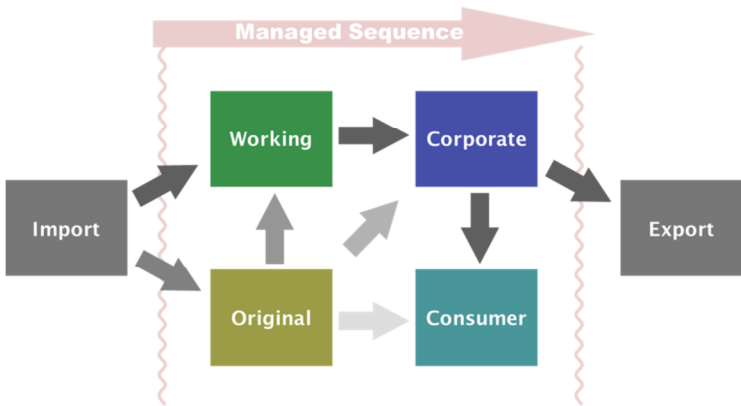


Figure 76: The roles that different repositories play

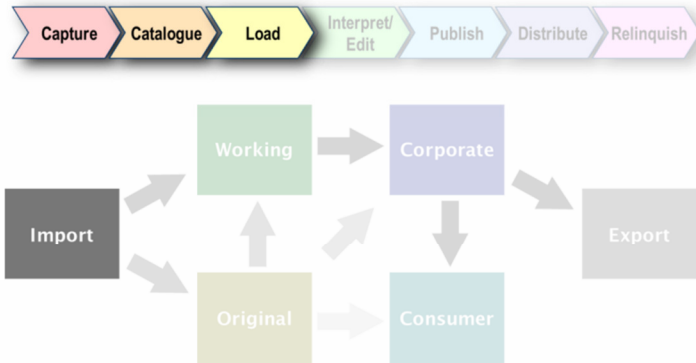


Figure 77: Activities that employ the import role

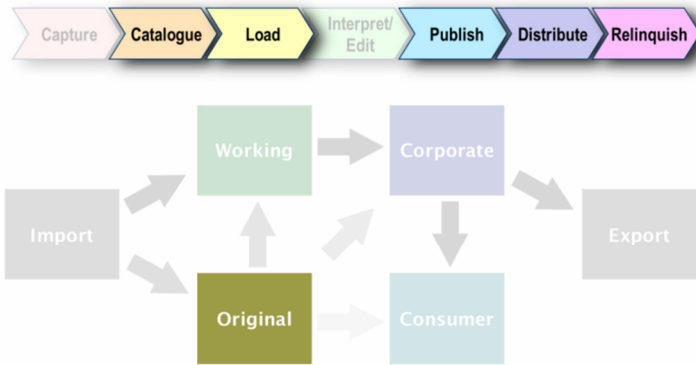


Figure 78: Activities that employ the original data role

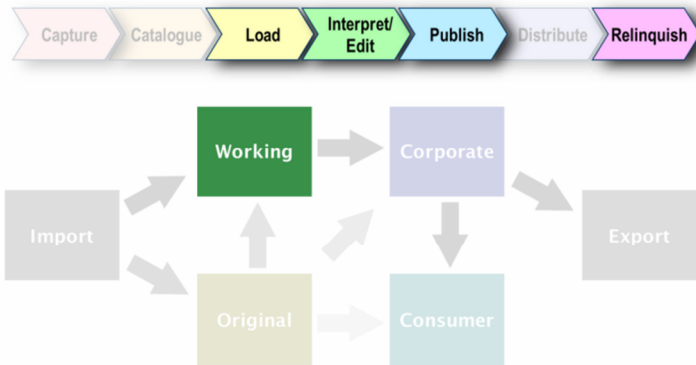


Figure 79: Activities that employ the working data role

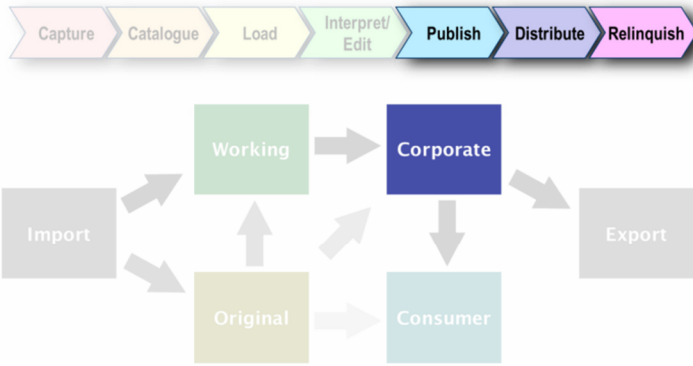


Figure 80: Activities that employ the corporate data role

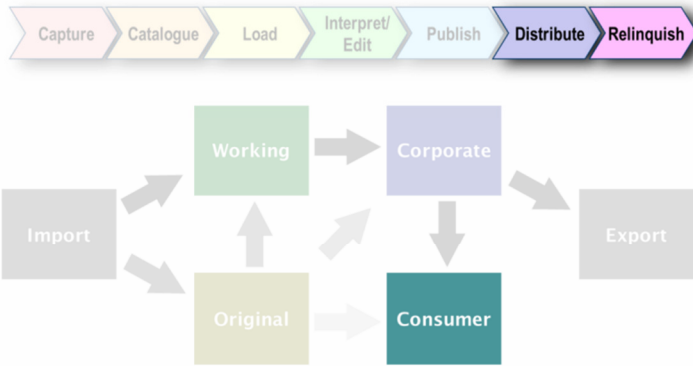


Figure 81: Activities that employ the data consumer role

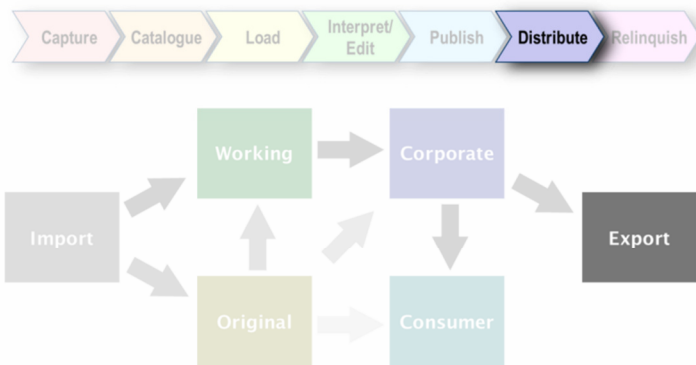


Figure 82: Activities that employ the export role

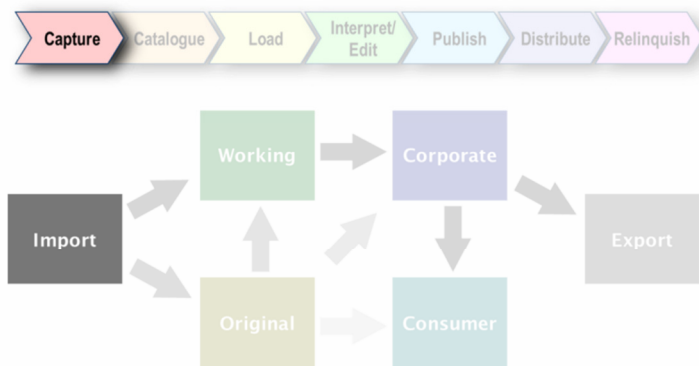


Figure 84: Roles involved in the "capture" activity

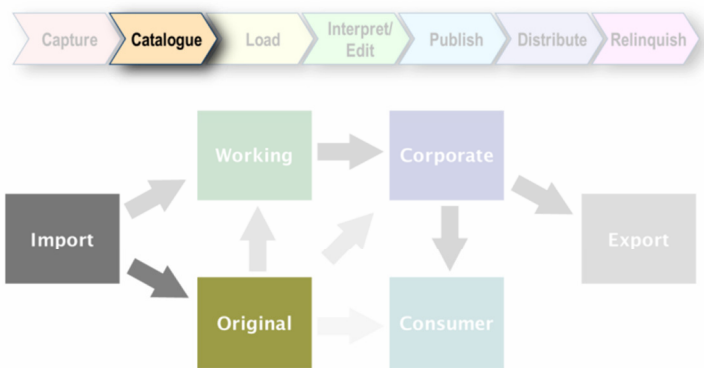


Figure 85: Roles involved in the “catalogue” activity

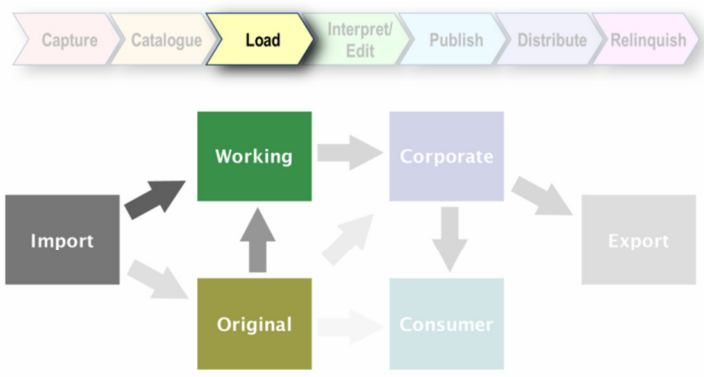


Figure 86: Roles involved in the “load” activity

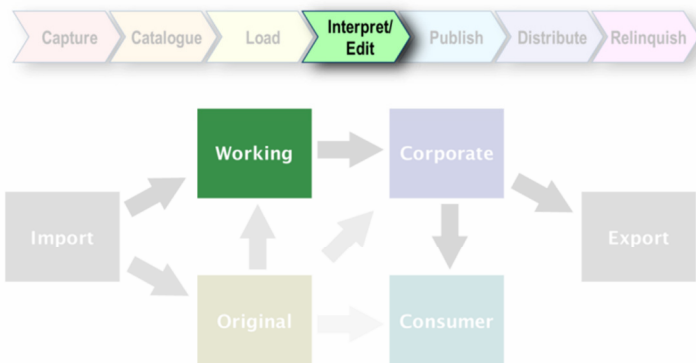


Figure 87: Roles involved in the “interpret” activity

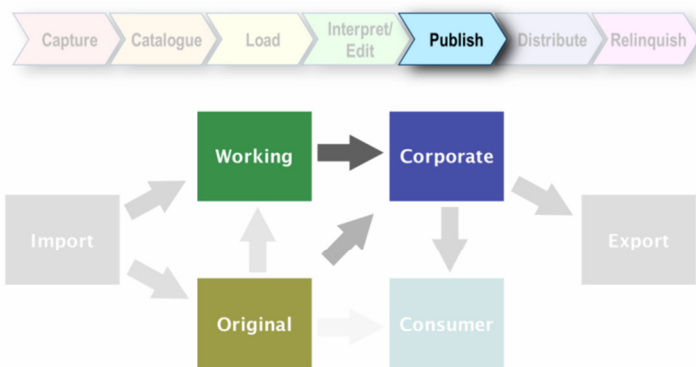


Figure 88: Roles involved in the “publish” activity

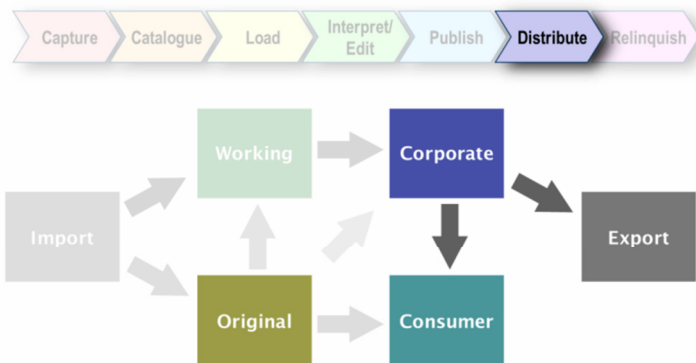


Figure 89: Roles involved in the “distribute” activity

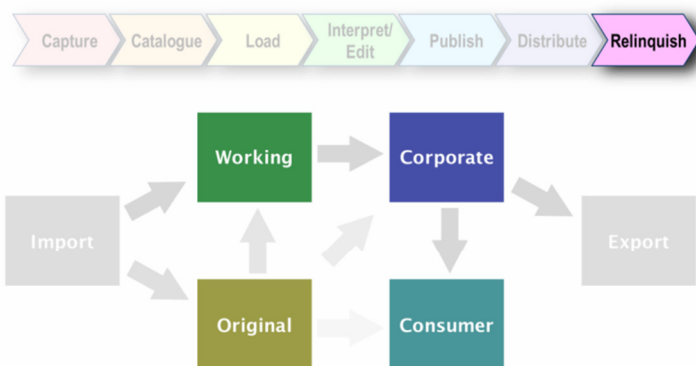


Figure 90: Roles involved in the “relinquish” activity
